On behalf of the ECOVE, which met on 29 May 2024, I hereby inform you of the outcome of the evaluation based on the ESEVT Full Visitation to your VEE on 4 - 8 March 2024.

The Committee concluded that no Major Deficiency had been found.

The Committee further concluded that three Minor Deficiencies had been found.

In accordance with the European System of Evaluation of Veterinary Training (ESEVT) and based on the educational requirements of the Directive 2005/36/EC as amended by Directive 2013/55/EU,

the status of the VEE of the University of León is ACCREDITATION

In line with the <u>ESEVT SOP 2023</u>, under which the visitation was completed, the status will be valid for seven years from the date of the visitation, i.e. until the **end of March 2031**.

In line with our agreement, please publish the SER and the Final Visitation Report on your website.

With respect to the three Minor Deficiencies (described in detail in the Visitation Report), following the adoption of the <u>SOP 2023</u> on 8 June 2023, the VEE is required to submit to the
