PAT's Standard Action Protocol

The Tutorial Action Plan (PAT) of the University of León aims:

- To provide comprehensive **support/guidance** to students, from their admission to their graduation, to contribute to their academic, personal, and professional development

- To establish **academic monitoring**, collecting feedback from the students, including comments, opinions, suggestions or complaints focused on the improvement of the quality of the courses

ACTUATION POINT DETECTION SYSTEM

INPUTS COLLECTION \rightarrow TUTOR'S REPORTS \rightarrow COORDINATOR

 $1^{st} \rightarrow$ **Identification** of possible areas of improvement, detected difficulties and/or specific problems, by means of the tools: face-to-face meetings students/tutor, anonymous surveys, tutoring via email and private conversations with students...

When a specific problem is detected → INTERNAL EVALUATION BY THE PAT'S TEAM (Coordinator and tutors of the course)

INTEGRATED FIRST LINE RESPONSE

2nd → To classify the problems detected **depending on their nature** (A: General comments/complaints or B: Specific difficulties concerning a student)

The **Dean's Office** of the Faculty is informed, and decisions are made internally, under the **Quality Management System (SGIC) of FVULE** and attempts are made to find a solution to the identified problem




The most common scenario is that PROBLEMS ARE RESOLVED AT THIS FIRST LINE RESPONSE

All tutor's and Coordinator's reports are sent and discussed with the **Evaluation and Quality Office** of the University of León, which serves to make inquiries, seek advice, and, occasionally, there may be something that requires the involvement of the **University's Ombudsman**



In the case of major issues, it is necessary to inform the **Rector's Office** of the University of León



INTEGRATED SECOND LINE RESPONSE

3rd→The specific problem is addressed in the framework of the **Course Councils** with the professors responsible for the subjects of each course and the student representatives of the course and the **Quality Committee**. **Resolution**→ **Final point of the Protocol**
